- **NEW FOR 2017**
 - THERE IS A CATEGORY FOR RECYCLING TREATMENTS; COLD IN-PLACE, HOT IN-PLACE, HEATER REPAVING, COLD CENTRAL PLANT RECYCLING, ETC.
 - THERE ARE MINIMUM PROJECT SIZES IN THE CITY STREET, URBAN HIGHWAY, RURAL HIGHWAY AND COMMERCIAL PARKING LOT CATEGORIES AS WELL AS A MINIMUM TREATMENT AREA FOR THE SURFACE TREATMENT CATEGORY.
 - ANY SINGLE PROJECT IS LIMITED TO BEING CONSIDERED FOR ONLY ONE CATEGORY.
- NOMINATIONS ARE LIMITED TO TWO PER COMPANY, PER AWARD CATEGORY (E.G., CITY STREET, URBAN HIGHWAY AND RURAL HIGHWAY).
- PROJECT LOCATION MAP. A MAP MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE SUBMITTAL. IT IS IMPORTANT TO INCLUDE WRITTEN PHYSICAL DIRECTIONS TO THE PROJECT ALONG WITH THE MAP. PROJECTS MAY BE EXCLUDED IF A MAP IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE SUBMITTAL.
- SUMMARY TEST DATA MUST BE INCLUDED FOR ALL CDOT HIGHWAY PROJECTS AND AIRPORT PROJECTS.
